Fire Safety Certificate

The content is designed to equip those studying it to undertake fire risk assessments in most, low risk workplaces. The syllabus is mapped to International standards and good practice from organizations such as the International Labour Organization (ILO), National Fire Protection Association (NFPA), International Code Council (ICC) and the Confederation of Fire Protection Association Europe (CFPA-Europe).

Upon successful completion of the certificate, delegates can apply for a membership with Institution of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH) and/or International Institute of Risk and Safety Management (IIRSM) as its qualification meets the academic requirements for Technician Membership (Tech IOSH) of IOSH and Associate membership (AIIRSM) of the



What does the course cover?

It covers risk assessments and ways to control common workplace hazards such as fire, lifting and carrying, work equipment, electrical safety, hazardous substances and transport.

The syllabus is divided into 2 units

- (1) Workplace safety foundations
- (2) Risk assessment activity

Course duration and how is the course assessed?

3 days plus a 45 minutes multiple choice examination and a two hour practical risk assessment which tests the participant's ability to put into practice the knowledge gained during the course.





Who should attend?

This course is recommended for anyone who is planning to perform internal audits/preparing to become an external auditor of OHSMS management system as per ISO 45001 standard.

ISO 45001 Auditors Migration Course (CQI IRCA)

This migration training course pack provides you the knowledge of the changes on the new standard ISO 45001 as compared to OHSAS 18001 and the skills required to audit against the new standard. It is recommended for professionals working in organizations certified to OHSAS 18001 standard that has been revised.

ISO 9001:2015 QMS Lead Auditor Course (CQI IRCA)

This course is designed to provide participants with the knowledge and skills required to perform first, second and third-party audits of management systems against the requirements of the ISO 9001:2015, in accordance with the guidance given in the ISO19011 for first and second party audits as well as the requirements of the ISO17021 for third-party audits.

Who should attend?

Anyone intending to perform audits of a quality management system. Note that, while this course is applicable to first, second, and third-party audits, this course is taught from the third party (Certification Body) perspective. An attendee can both start their journey down the third-party auditor route, and/or have an understanding of what third party auditors look for.

Integrated Management System Internal Auditor Course (ISO 9001:2015, ISO 14001:2015 & ISO 45001:2018)

To enable participants to gain a practical knowledge of how to seek compliance & audit integrated Quality, Environment & Occupational Health and Safety Management systems to comply with the requirements as per ISO 9001:2015, ISO 14001:2015 & ISO 45001:2018 and to effectively participate in the implementation of requirements.

Accredited Practical Courses

Emergency Preparedness

In all cases where there is potential serious harm to people at work and affected by work, emergency preparedness by way of proper planning and testing will reduce the consequences of on-site emergencies and help to mitigate the effects. On this two day training, workers will learn how to be prepared and correctly respond during an emergency.

Confined Space Entry And Rescue

This two day course is physical and will be probably more physical than the delegate encounters in their normal daily workplace. Participants will be taught on the use of the tripod/quad pod plus either winch or retractable retrievable fall arrest block as a means of access to confined spaces, plus rescue and emergency evacuation from either a horizontal or vertical confined space. This program is only recommended for participants who are physically fit and healthy.

Fire fighting

This one day program is a combination of theory and practical training on fire prevention and fire fighting techniques. The course will take the participants through a range of fire related topics; principles of fire triangle, location of fire fighting equipment and

escape routes, fire chemistry and ignition sources, fire hazards, flammable materials and fire spread, need for vigilance and readiness for emergency response, fire/smoke detection and alarm systems, portable fire fighting equipment, PPE & RPE. The afternoon practical session includes using hand-held firefighting equipment on real fires. Every participant takes part in using the extinguishers.

Fire Warden

This course is designed to help participants understand:

- Evacuation and assembly principles and procedures
- · Fire, bomb threat, and other emergencies and their
- Eeffects on the workplace
- Fire equipment and correct method of fighting a fire
- Efficient evacuation of the workplace with consideration of special people who may require additional assistance


